From the Pastor's Desk


In Doris Kearns Goodwin's illuminating biography, Team of Rivals: The Political Genius of Abraham Lincoln she compares the lives of four political rivals; William Henry Seward, Edward Bates, Solomon Chase, and Abraham Lincoln. They had many things in common; ambition, passion for knowledge, and drive to make a difference in the world. The one thing that distinguished Lincoln from the rest was difficult and challenging circumstances. This ranged from losses in childhood to impoverished conditions. Somehow Lincoln's deficits became a driving force in his life. The sovereign Lord can take all aspects of our lives and make them work for good. As we reflect on the challenges of the past year and look forward to the coming year with eyes of faith, hope, and love it will be important to keep this in mind.

Our stewardship emphasis this past month has been a chance to reflect on the past year and look forward to where the Lord is leading us. To keep us connected in worship we invested nearly \$8500 in equipment to broadcast the service via Facebook and the website. We improved our website and figured out how to do church meetings via Zoom. Our Deacons continued and expanded their pastoral care ministry. We started new prayer and fellowship groups online. We adopted Amber Hills staff while continuing our ministry to Whitstran Elementary, our adopted school. We expanded our Emergency Fund to help those who were struggling financially and expanded our ministry with Jubilee Ministries for those struggling in our community. We came alongside of many through packets delivered and picked up at church (VBS in a box, gift bags for local pastors, Christmas Eve packets, Thanksgiving food boxes, Christmas food boxes, youth packets, treat bags for PSD staff).


In the coming year we are planning to restart our existing ministries with a special focus on several "recovery" ministries which we believe will be vital for us and the community of Prosser. We will restart Grief-share which helps those working through grief and we will start Divorce-care which works in a similar way for those working through divorce. We will start a new ministry called Celebrate Recovery which is a Christian 12 step group helping folks find freedom from addictions. We are also exploring programs that assist with financial recovery like "Faith and Finances." Additionally, we are looking forward to starting a 3-month paid internship for a senior high or college age youth giving them the opportunity to develop leadership skills and experience in ministry. All of this and more is possible because the Lord Jesus Christ has and will continue to provide through your generosity and willingness to serve!

This coming Sunday, February 7, is our Celebration Sunday which is the culmination of our stewardship emphasis. Typically, we come forward to lay our commitments before the Lord at the front of the sanctuary. Ellie and I will do this during our online service as part of our commitment to the Lord's work here. 


