

From the Pastor's Desk

“Deep Roots”

This is the time of year when people are getting busy in their yards and gardens. A time for enjoying all the Lord’s gift of creation. For plants to grow to their full potential there must have an extensive root system. We too need deep roots. We need this individually and as a church family. Each one of us is like a plant and together we are like a garden. Roots search for the sources of life. We draw our life from the One who created and designed us – the Lord Jesus Christ. I see this year as a time for all of us to strengthen our roots. This will happen in a couple of ways.

First, we are starting a sermon series on the book of 1 Peter. The Apostle Peter’s letter is a hard-hitting book. It calls us to live a radical discipleship in challenging times. The people Peter writes to are hard-living people who are experiencing trials. Peter encourages them, but also pushes them not to compromise. Creating deep roots often requires that we push ourselves. Breaking up hard soil, removing old roots and big rocks is hard work. Why not make it a goal over the next 2 months to spend time daily in 1 Peter as we journey through it as a church family? The book also provides the opportunity to grow deeper intellectually. How about picking up a commentary on 1 Peter to supplement your reading? Wayne Grudem’s and Scot McKnight’s commentaries are good options. Another interesting read could be Adam Hamilton’s Simon Peter: Flawed but Faithful Disciple.


As I mentioned above creating deep roots require clearing the ground of obstacles. Our leaders will be going through a process of prayerfully considering what we learned in this past year. What are things that we will set aside? I suggest that each of us needs to do this on personal level as well. Have there been habits or routines that you have fallen into this past year that are not helpful for deep roots? Additionally, we will be asking what are new things that we gained. Like the importance of relationships and unity together. How about you?

On a similar note, one of the things we do not want to continue from last year is the lack of in person worship. We are in person and that will continue. The concerns about Benton county going back to Phase 2 will not change anything that we are currently doing in our worship services. The phases have to do with capacity and we still have room to expand capacity especially since so many of our church family is vaccinated.

ALBERT DON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Albert Don Memorial Scholarships was established in 2021 in honor of Albert Don, a respected innovator in the ag and grape community. Albert was a lifelong resident of Prosser where he started his career with Wyckoff Farms and stayed for over 30 years. He played the role of not only farmer, but also of innovator with mechanical pruning, hedging, and mechanical thinning practices that led the industry. In 2003, he earned the Washington Winegrowers Association's 'Grower of the Year' award to recognize his demonstrated viticultural skills that provide impact in the vineyard and in the bottle—creating the atmosphere of a perfect grape in the vineyard.

The Albert Don Memorial Scholarship will annually award \$3,000 to one student pursuing an education in viticulture or wine business management.
