From The Pastor's Desk "Our Journey to Easter"

In the early church Easter (Resurrection Day) was a time of great celebration. New believers were baptized that day as a sign of the significance of Jesus' death and resurrection. These new believers were brought to the shore of a lake or river. They wore their old clothes and when it was time for baptism, they would discard the old clothes. After their baptism they would be clothed in new white robes to signify the new life they entered into because of what the Lord Jesus Christ had done for them. It seems to me that this year as we journey through Lent (40 days leading to Easter or Resurrection Day) we are starting to shake off the old clothes of the pandemic and its effects. While there is still much brokenness in our world, we have been given a sure and certain hope in the Lord Jesus' death and resurrection which we will celebrate on Easter (April 17th).

During this season of Lent, part of our preparation for Easter is to walk together, as a church family, through the book of James. James, the brother of Jesus, challenges us to look at our lives and start discarding some of the "old clothes" that are really not consistent with life in Jesus Christ. He touches on our attitude toward trials and challenges, issues with anger, learning to listen, using our words to build up rather than tearing down, and the need to refrain from showing favoritism, to name a few. I encourage you to prayerfully read the book of James during Lent and ask the Lord to show you what needs to be set aside and what new clothes you need to put on.

All of this leads up to our Hope of Easter emphasis. We all need hope and the only lasting and solid hope is found in the Lord Jesus Christ. Palm Sunday, Good Friday (April 15 @ 7p) and Easter will emphasize this hope and following Easter we will look together at what difference the Resurrection makes in our lives. This is good news and we want to share the good news of hope in Jesus Christ with the world. We are going to work hard to get the word out and give you a chance to invite your friends, neighbors, co-workers, and family members! Please pray about who you might invite and ask the Holy Spirit to provide the opportunity to extend those invitations. People are thinking about the Christian faith and church during the Easter season and an invitation from a friend can be all it takes.

Update on Isaac from Thailand

Isaac, a 12-year-old boy in Thailand, was born with severe scoliosis. He was orphaned at a young age and his relatives lived in a rural mountain village and didn't have access to a hospital to treat him. His family moved to a community just outside of Chiang Mai City when he was about 7 years old, which is where Jojo's Sanctuary staff met him a few years later. They took Isaac and his family to get a medical assessment and the doctor determined Isaac needed intensive corrective spinal surgery in order to have a normal life. Due to Covid lockdowns and costs, the needed surgery was postponed, and during this time, his spinal curvature has become significantly pronounced.

Jojo's Sanctuary (www.jojosthailand.org) started in 2016 providing child protection workshops for at-risk children and youth in Chiang Mai Province. The organization has grown as it has provided support and education for youth and families at higher risk of abuse or dropping out of school. Isaac and his family were members of Building Family Dreams, a family strengthening program for low-income families. We at Covenant Presbyterian Church have supported JoJo's Sanctuary for many years. They are working on getting Isaac insurance at the hospital, and this plus what the family can provide will cover some of the costs, but \$5500 is still needed. *Will you join us as we help this family achieve their dream of a normal life for Isaac?*
