From The Pastor's Desk "Our Lenten Journey"

The most important celebration for followers of Jesus is Easter (Resurrection Day) which will be Sunday, March 31 this year. Because of the importance of this day believers over the years used as a time of reflection and preparation. In the early church those who were going to join the church would go through a time of preparation during this season known as Lent. New believers would then be baptized on Easter as a sign of the significance of Jesus' death and resurrection. Those who were already believers focused on prayer, fasting, and reflection on the significance of the Lord Jesus death and resurrection. This is where the practice of giving something up for Lent came from.

During this season of Lent, part of our preparation for Easter is to walk together, as a church family, through the ten commandments in the book of Deuteronomy. My hope is that this will give us a chance to reflect on our lives and why we need the Lord Jesus by the power of the Spirit to help us to live and love the way God designed us. I also hope to show why the Old Testament and the ten commandments are central to our journey with Jesus. It is very easy for Christians today to set aside the Old Testament as an antiquated set of laws that no longer apply however Jesus did not see it that way. Jesus said, "Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them. I tell you the truth, until heaven and earth disappear, not the smallest letter, not the least stroke of a pen, will by any means disappear from the Law until everything is accomplished (Matthew 5:17-18). What role do the ten commandments play in your journey with Jesus and our lives together as a church family?

All of this leads up to the hope of Easter. We all need hope and the only lasting and solid hope is found in the Lord Jesus Christ. Palm Sunday and Easter will emphasize this hope. This is good news and we want to share the good news of hope in Jesus Christ with the world. We are going to work hard to get the word out and give you a chance to invite your friends, neighbors, co-workers, and family members! Please pray about who you might invite and ask the Holy Spirit to provide the opportunity to extend those invitations. People are thinking about the Christian faith and church during the Easter season and an invitation from a friend can be all it takes.

Celebrate Recovery is a Bible-based, Christ-centered recovery program for those who struggle with life's hurts, habits and hang-ups. Its curriculum takes participants through The 8 Recovery Principles which are based on the Beatitudes.

WHO STARTED CELEBRATE RECOVERY?

Celebrate Recovery was created in 1991 by Pastors Rick Warren and John Baker at Saddleback Church in California. It is now used in over 35,000 churches worldwide.

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF CELEBRATE RECOVERY?

The purpose of Celebrate Recovery is to fellowship together and celebrate God's healing power in our lives by sharing our experience, strength, and hope through The 12 Steps and The 8 Recovery Principles. This experience allows us to "be changed".

WHO IS CELEBRATE RECOVERY FOR?

You may be thinking that recovery is only for those with alcohol or drug problems. This could not be further from the truth. Most of life's hurts, habits and hang -ups can be addressed through this one ministry, including problems with abuse, anger, grief, alcohol, drugs, depression, guilt and shame, financial loss, divorce, dysfunctional families, sexual problems, eating disorders, and much more!


