From The Pastor's Desk

So, what have you got planned for this summer? Vacation, time with family, work projects? All good things, but I want to suggest something spiritually transformative along with all those other things. This summer we as a church family are going to travel through a book of the Bible that has changed the world by changing people. Martin Luther the German monk who started the protestant reformation said that because of this book:

I grasped that the righteousness of God is righteousness by which through grace and sheer mercy God justifies us by faith. Thereupon I felt myself to be reborn and to have gone through open doors into paradise... I broke through. And as I had formerly hated the expression 'the righteousness of God,' I now began to regard it as my dearest and most comforting word.

John Calvin who was one of the founders of the Reformed tradition said that this book was his:

entrance... to all the most hidden treasures of Scripture... The subject then of these chapters may be stated thus – man's only righteousness is through the mercy of God in Christ, which being offered by the gospel is apprehended by faith.

This book has had a transformative effect on Christians throughout the ages. It has been referred to as the 5th gospel. If you haven't guessed already, it is the book of Romans. Why not make the book of Romans your prayerful focus for the summer? You could use each of the Sunday passages as part of devotional reading for that week. There maybe verses that the Spirit of God draws to your attention that are worth memorizing. Each passage each week can become a jumping off point for your prayer life. For example, Romans 1:8 says, "First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for all of you, because your faith is being reported all over the world." This could lead you to daily pray for those you are thankful for. This kind of spiritual focus could make this a summer like no other. Why not?

The Building & Stewardship Team would like to summarize what was covered at our congregational meeting in March to be transparent and communicate the best we can with our church family.

The 2023 budget was approved by Session with the following steps in place due to a shortfall:

- * Session to re-evaluate our income and expenses in July and make adjustments if needed. This is common practice to look at budget half way through the year.
- * Session will ask the Prosser Market Street LLC (rental house income) board to increase their monthly contribution to the church to \$1250/month. This has been approved.
- * Each team was asked to look at their budget and trim where they could. This has been completed. Keep in mind most teams do not spend their full budget.
- * There were a few hourly positions that had extra hours built in and those have been adjusted in effort to help the overall budget.

At the end of the congregational meeting we asked the church family to prayerfully consider an increase in their giving. We appreciate your commitment and generosity!

CHILDREN'S CHURCH

Children's Church will begin Sunday, June 11. For kids preschool through 5th grade. They will be dismissed after the Children's Sermon.

The church received a letter from Joel Whitehead, Executive Director of Camp Ghormley. Here is an abbreviated version of his letter. There is always an opportunity to donate to Camp Ghormley but he is specifically asking for camp scholarship donations. There are many families that are in need of scholarships to help get their kids to camp. This gift will help a camper experience the summer of a lifetime and true transformation in Jesus. When a young person comes to Camp Ghormley they are joined by over a hundred other young people and camp staff who all want the same thing-to see Jesus transform their life for the better. As one group they get to spend a week together in the mountains worshipping Jesus with singing, laughing, crying, and praying. Your gift will help a family send their camper.

We, CPC, want to share this information with you in the event that you are able to send a gift directly to them. Thank you!

In January we received an email from Heather Askew, Jojo's Sanctuary, with an update on Isaac. The entire situation has been and is complicated but is summarized below.

Recently a new law passed that stateless children can access free or discounted health care. This is huge for Isaac as he doesn't have any documentation and is stateless. They received his card and was transferred, a few times, to different hospitals but landed at the Suandok hospital for the care he needs (this is a great hospital according to Heather).

In a single day at the Suandok hospital they were able to meet with three doctors and got six appointments scheduled over six weeks. He had an MRI, met with a cardiologist, blood work, CT Scan, met with a pediatrician, and met with the orthopedic surgeons to go over all the results and discuss next steps all in the month of January. All of the scans of his internal organs are normal.

Isaac's pediatrician said with this severe of a scoliosis case, it can influence so many other things in the body. So, with no medical history at all (he had so many caretakers in his early life and nobody ever took him to the doctor for any sort of checkups) she wants to get all the information she can so the surgeons can put together the best plan for how to do the surgery. If he has issues with other internal organs, they will need those specialists to assist with the surgery.

Due to the severity of this case the surgeon has been able to schedule Isaac's surgery for **August 4!** Between now and then he has a lot of appointments to prepare for the surgery but initially we thought he would have to wait another four years. Praise the Lord!

God is amazing and his timing is wonderful-we give God all the glory. Thank you for your continued support and prayers. Isaac and his adoptive mom are so grateful and wish they could thank you in person.
