From The Pastor’s Desk

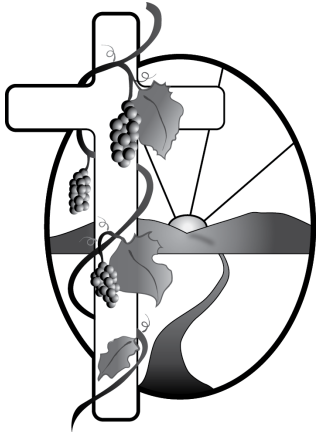

The good thing about times like this is that they can push us to re-evaluate our priorities. Perhaps seeking the God who is the source of life and hope has been something that you have been thinking about. This fall could and maybe should be a time of personal renewal for all of us in our walk with the Lord Jesus. This would also be a great time to invite someone to church.

This fall we want to jump back into life together with our “Hope is Here” campaign. 1 Peter reminds us that in and through Jesus Christ and his resurrection we have been given “a living hope.” We will be looking at the hope we have because of: the promises of God, the victory in the spiritual battle, our inheritance as sons and daughters of God, and the power of prayer. 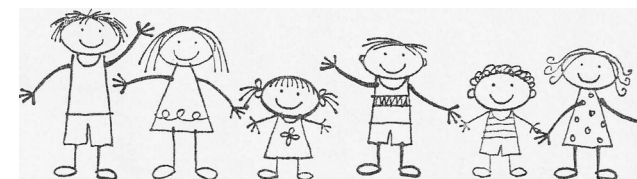
