## ***From The Pastor's Desk***

On Sunday, October 9 we started a new sermon series on the book of Galatians. Galatians focuses on the gospel of Jesus Christ - that by faith alone as a result of God's grace alone we become part of God's rescue plan for His creation. This book has been a pivotal work in the lives of believers throughout Christian history. It makes it clear that you are brought into a right relationship with God purely as an act of God's grace and you can do nothing to earn it. God's grace sets you free from the tyranny of measuring up and opens the door to a Spirit-filled life of joy, fullness, meaning, and calling. Jesus Christ comes to live in you and by the power of the Spirit your life begins to express Christ in you.

As always when we are working our way through a book of the Bible, I encourage you to read that book as part of your prayer and devotional time. Reading a portion of Scripture every day asking the Spirit to teach will enrich your journey with the Lord. It also gives us a chance to walk through it together as a church family. If you want additional readings I suggest Phillip Yancey's book, What's So Amazing About Grace? and/or Scot McKnight's commentary on Galatians (The NIV Application Commentary). If your small group has not started up yet this would be a good time to get everyone back together or join a group or even start a group (talk to Pastor Paul).





## *Financial goal has been met!*

Isaac, a 12-year-old boy in Thailand, was born with severe scoliosis. He was orphaned at a young age and his relatives lived in a rural mountain village and didn't have access to a hospital to treat him. His family moved to a community just outside of Chiang Mai City when he was about 7 years old, which is where Jojo's Sanctuary staff met him a few years later. They took Isaac and his family to get a medical assessment and the doctor determined Isaac needed intensive corrective spinal surgery in order to have a normal life. Due to Covid lockdowns and costs, the needed surgery was postponed, and during this time, his spinal curvature has become significantly pronounced.

*UPDATE: Through many generous donors in our church family, community, and beyond Jojo's Sanctuary has raised \$5000 for Isaac's surgery. Thank you for being a significant part of his journey through prayer and financial assistance. God is Good!*

*Isaac had a doctors appointment in June and the doctor said he is not ready for surgery and needs about six more months of physical therapy. Prayers that Isaac will be diligent about his daily exercises and be encouraged by his family.*




