From The Pastor’s Desk

In history Fall has been a time for bringing in the harvest and giving thanks for all that the Lord has provided. Remember that holiday called “Thanksgiving.” We, as a church family, can give thanks for a wonderful “Back to Church Sunday” and the corresponding “Hope is Here” emphasis. We had a big Sunday with great attendance and terrific food, fellowship, and family-style games. Small groups have been meeting to pray, study, and share life together as they have been looking at Max Lucado’s book, Unshakable Hope. Several of these are new groups.

This coming Sunday we will start a new sermon series on the Psalms. Many of the psalms share a common theme of giving thanks to the Lord for his many blessings. If you would like to dig in a little deeper into the Psalms, I recommend C.S. Lewis’ Reflections on The Psalms and Peter Santucci’s Everyday Psalms. Lewis’s book is a deeper look into the nature of the Psalms and Santucci’s book provides an insightful translation of each Psalm. If you made it a goal to read a Psalm every day Santucci’s book could be a great asset.

We can also be thankful for the opportunity that we have as a church family to make a life-changing difference in the lives of people here and abroad. On Sunday, October 24th we will have the chance to hear from Heather Askew about her work in Thailand. Heather is from Prosser and has been doing work with children and families in Thailand. The work of Jojo’s sanctuary helps with short-term placement for kids caught in abuse and trafficking. They also do ant-trafficking training with children and families through workshops for low-income families. The Session had the chance to meet with Heather via Zoom and we wanted you to be able to hear what we heard. Prior to Covid we were planning on a mission trip to Thailand to assist in a family camp for kids and families. Our support for Heather is our way of extending the hope of the Lord Jesus Christ beyond Prosser.

I continue to be excited about what the Lord has for us and you are an important part of it!






