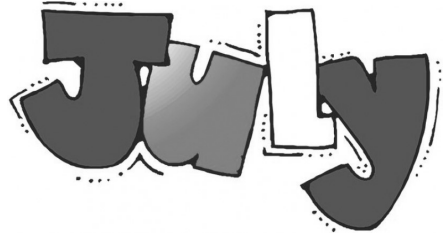

From the Pastor's Desk



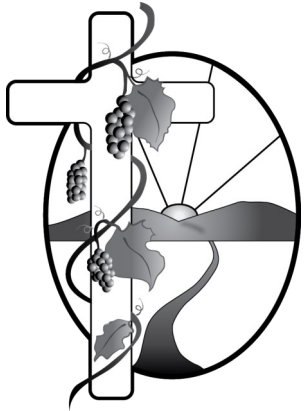
When I was in grade school, we used to play a game that was vaguely related to football. Someone would throw or kick the football and then whoever caught it would run anywhere he could. Everyone else tried to tackle him. We did not bother with boundaries or end zones. That was far too organized. When the person with the football was actually tackled, we would all “pile on” that kid. Fortunately, none of us were all that big so there wasn’t too much damage. We would do this over and over again and we thought it was great fun. I am really not sure why.

It seems like whenever I turn on the news it is kind of like a “pile on.” One thing after another keeps landing on us. We are certainly living in tumultuous times. I find that it helps to remind myself that others in this journey of faith have had “pile on” kinds of experiences. I am sure Joseph felt “piled on” by his brothers and then circumstances of his life. I imagine that David felt the same as he was pursued by King Saul. All of the churches in the time of the New Testament lived under Roman occupation and experienced persecution. In all those circumstances the Scriptures remind us that God was faithful.

One of the New Testament churches that was experiencing some “pile on” was the church in Thessalonica. As the Apostle Paul wrote them, he said, “Be joyful always; pray continually; give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God’s will for you in Christ Jesus” (1 Thessalonians 4:16-18). I find it helpful to take a break from the news and the social media stuff. If I go through my day looking for the things that I can be thankful for because the Lord of All has the whole world in His hands, I am strengthened psychologically, emotionally, and spiritually. Thankfulness in all circumstances teaches me to look for the hand of God and to trust in Him. It is a great spiritual discipline to practice every day. Give it a try.

Recently I have read several books and articles on youth ministry trends. The research shows several trends that are of interest. The trend I want to share with you is the level of teamwork between youth team and parents. The greater the strength of that relationship between parents and team, the better the outcome of the youth ministry program. When parents connect with the youth team, they are able to reinforce the lessons learned. By asking questions about what the youth are learning they give value to both their youth and the ministry. The more multigenerational engagement (parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles) the better. In an effort to improve this area I am asking three things. If you have a youth in our program reach out to me on ways to connect and engage with our program. Second ANYONE that has a heart for these youth and wants to be of service contact me and we will find a way to plug you into the program that works for you and the program. Third please pray for our youth, for the youth team, for those that are not yet a part of our church community.
