#### From The Pastor's Desk

#### "Advent & The Prince of Peace"

Advent is a time of celebrating when the Lord God Almighty came into our world. As Eugene Peterson put it in the The Message Bible, "he (Jesus, Son of God) moved into our neighborhood." More importantly Advent is a time of looking forward to him coming again to complete the work of the Kingdom of God. So what will this Kingdom be like? One passage that is typically read during the season of Advent gives us a 'glimpse' of the nature of this new Kingdom. Isaiah 9:6 tells us, "For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace." We believe this passage was pointing forward to the Lord Jesus as the Messiah. There is a lot packed into this verse, but our emphasis on peace this Advent pleads with us to take a closer look at the last three words, "Prince of Peace." The Hebrew 'sar' that is translated prince is usually used to describe a commander or captain of an army. This is a person who is in charge. He is in charge of those who have made the choice to make him the commander of their lives. The Hebrew 'shalom' that is translated peace means completeness, wholeness, soundness, welfare, or peace. The Lord Jesus is commanding a group of people bringing a fullness and wholeness. We are not whole without the One we were designed to be in a day-to-day relationship with.

What we seek to do as a church family is to give people a glimpse of the wholeness or fullness of the life that is found in the Lord Jesus Christ. When we give and deliver Christmas gifts to families from Whitstran on Sunday, December 17 we give them a glimpse of God's goodness and love. When we use our artistic gifts to put on a Christmas Eve service it shows people that the Lord Jesus is worthy of worship and that beautiful artistic expressions are a central part of the wholeness and fullness found in the Lord of All. When we have a special Sunday like Candy Cane Sunday, December 10 it reminds us and all our guests that the joy of the Lord is central to the very nature of the Lord and his Kingdom. When you invite your friend, neighbor, or co-worker to join you in any of this you give them the chance to get a little glimpse of the wholeness or fullness of life that the Lord Jesus intends for them. Something worth praying and thinking about.


