The first Sunday of every month is an opportunity for our church family to celebrate the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ through partaking in the Lord's Supper. We want everyone who has placed their faith in Jesus Christ to have the opportunity to participate, but we are aware that some in our family are not able to get out due to bad weather or physical problems. However, our Deacons will be available to bring Communion to those who want to receive it on that Sunday. Please call the church office (786-1594) and let us know if you aren't going to be able to be in church and would like to have Communion in your home.



We have removed the last pew and have placed a few chairs with wheelchair signs there. We ask to reserve these spaces for those who are in wheelchairs so that they and their families have easy access to the sanctuary. Thank you, we want all to feel welcome.

As our security team continues to meet on a monthly basis we are slowly implementing security measures and working on policy and procedures in stages.

Sunday morning worship

We are locking the south (Yakima Ave.) entrance doors when church begins at 10am and will leave east (Market St.) doors unlocked. During worship we will have one person from the security team that will monitor and walk the narthex during church.

Youth Group-Wednesday nights

Once our youth group kids are all here the doors will be locked for the remaining time of youth group. We have doorbells at each entrance so if you need in at any time please feel free to use that.

Preschool Security Measures

The church doors will be locked during Kiddie Korner Preschool school hours. Their hours are as follows: Monday 9-11:30, Tuesday/Thursday 9-1:30, Wednesday 9-11. If you have a church key please let yourself in and lock the door behind you or we have installed doorbells at each entrance to make this process more convenient.

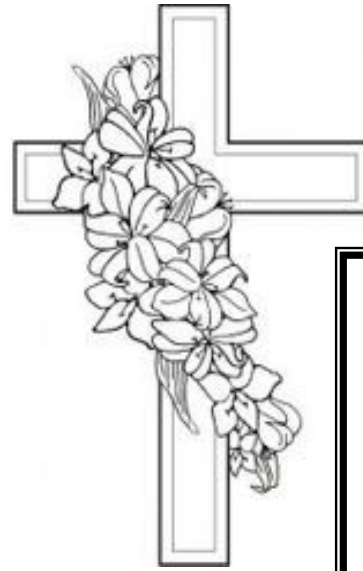

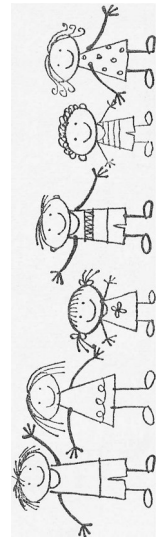
